I. UNDERSTAND HOW GOD WORKS IN YOUR LIFE:

Examples: – Noah (Genesis 6-9) – Joseph (Genesis 37-45)
– Abraham (Genesis 17-22) – Moses (Exodus 2-15)
– Jesus (John 14-20) – David (1 Samuel 16-32)

PHASE 1: GOD GIVES YOU A VISION

PHASE 2: A DECISION

Decide to invest: The time to follow the vision.

Decide to let go of: Security

PHASE 3: DELAY

PHASE 4: DIFFICULTIES

PHASE 5: DEAD END

PHASE 6: DELIVERANCE

2 Corinthians 1:8-9, "For we would not, brethren, have you ignorant of our trouble which came to us in Asia, that we were pressed out of measure, above strength, insomuch that we despaired even of life: But we had the sentence of death in ourselves, that we should not trust in ourselves, but in God which raiseth the dead:"

II. LEARN HOW TO W-A-I-T ON GOD.

Withstand

Ephesians 6:11-16, "Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked."

4 "Darts": DOUBTS, DEPRESSION, DISCOURAGEMENT, DETOUR

Psalms 27:14, "Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD."

Anticipate

Psalms 27:13, "I had fainted, unless I had believed to see the goodness of the LORD in the land of the living."

Psalms 130:5, "I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope."

Intercede

Luke 18:1, "And he spake a parable unto them to this end, that men ought always to pray, and not to faint;"

Psalms 5:3, "My voice shalt thou hear in the morning, O LORD; in the morning will I direct my prayer unto thee, and will look up."

Trust

Psalms 37:5-7, "Commit thy way unto the LORD; trust also in him; and he shall bring it to pass. Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for him: fret not thyself because of him who prospereth in his way, because of the man who bringeth wicked devices to pass."

Ecclesiastes 3:1-11, "To every thing there is a season, and a time to every purpose under the heaven: He hath made every thing beautiful in his time: also he hath set the world in their heart, so that no man can find out the work that God maketh from the beginning to the end."
