

## James 4:17,

“Therefore to him that knoweth to do good, and doeth it not, to him  
**IT IS SIN.”**

Titus 2:14, “Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity, and purify unto himself a peculiar people,  
ZEALOUS OF GOOD WORKS.”

Matthew 5:16, “Let your light so shine before men, that they may SEE YOUR GOOD WORKS, and glorify your Father  
which is in heaven.”

Acts 9:36, “Now there was at Joppa a certain disciple named Tabitha, which by interpretation is called Dorcas: this  
woman was FULL OF GOOD WORKS and almsdeeds which she did.”

Ephesians 2:10, “For we are his workmanship, CREATED IN CHRIST JESUS UNTO GOOD WORKS, which God hath before  
ordained that we should walk in them.”

Ephesians 2:8-10, “For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: Not of  
works, lest any man should boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus unto good works, which God  
hath before ordained that we should walk in them.”

1 Timothy 5:9-10, “Let not a WIDOW be taken into the number under threescore years old, . . . WELL REPORTED OF FOR  
GOOD WORKS;”

1 Timothy 6:18, “That they do good, that THEY BE RICH IN GOOD WORKS, ready to distribute, willing to communicate;”

Titus 3:8, “This is a faithful saying, and these things I will that thou affirm constantly, THAT THEY WHICH HAVE  
BELIEVED IN GOD MIGHT BE CAREFUL TO MAINTAIN GOOD WORKS. These things are good and profitable unto  
men.”

Hebrews 10:24, “And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to GOOD WORKS:”

### 1. Eli

1 Samuel 3:13, “For I have told him that I will judge his house for ever for the iniquity which he knoweth;  
because his sons made themselves vile, and HE RESTRAINED THEM NOT.”

1 Samuel 4:11, “And the ark of God was taken; and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, were slain.”

### 2. The Unfaithful Steward

Matthew 25:15, “And unto one he gave five talents, to another two, and to another one; to every man according  
to his several ability; and straightway took his journey.”

Matthew 25:25-29, “And I was afraid, and went and hid thy talent in the earth: lo, there thou hast that is thine.  
His lord answered and said unto him, Thou wicked and slothful servant, thou knewest that I reap where I  
sowed not, and gather where I have not strawed: Thou oughtest therefore to have put my money to the  
exchangers, and then at my coming I should have received mine own with usury. Take therefore the talent  
from him, and give it unto him which hath ten talents. For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he  
shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.”

### 3. The Priest And The Levite
