Jonah 1:6-17

I. Their gods did not answer. (vs.6)

I Kings 18 – Elijah, Ahab and the burnt sacrifice

II. Jonah’s walk did not match his talk. (vs. 9-10)

John 13:35 “By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have love one to another.”

John 14:15 “If ye love me, keep my commandments.”

III. They showed more compassion for Jonah than he showed for the city of Ninevah. (vs. 13)

IV. Other people cannot prevent God from getting our attention. (vs. 13)

V. The way that we view our circumstances depends upon the way that we view our God. (vs. 17)

Jonah 1:1-5

I. God communicates with His children. (vs.1)

II. God commands us to share His message with others.(vs. 2)

III. Disobeying God’s command is costly. (vs. 3)

IV. Jonah could not hide from God and neither can we. (vs. 4)

V. God will get our attention when we try to run from Him. (vs. 4)

VI. My disobedience to God affects others. (vs. 5)
